

USE ACCORDING TO COPYRIGHT LAW



On the institutional repository PubData of Leuphana University Lüneburg, authors can specify for each of their objects (files) how the content may be reused by others. The scope of this reuse is regulated by copyright law and can also be specified via free licenses. If a publication is not published under a free license, use of the object is only permitted within the framework of copyright regulations.

German copyright law applies exclusively to the reuse of the object if the author only has a simple right of use to the object. This is often the case if the publication has already appeared elsewhere (e.g., with a publisher). Furthermore, parts of an object (such as illustrations or individual chapters) may only be used in accordance with copyright law without the consent of the respective rights holder and may not be placed under a free license.

This object is protected by German copyright law. The terms of use defined in the next section apply.

Terms of use according to copyright law

A simple, non-transferable, personal, and limited right to use the object is granted. The object may be downloaded, stored, printed, and cited for scientific purposes and personal use. Further distribution or public reproduction, as well as any commercial use, is not permitted and may only take place with the express permission of the copyright holder. The object may not be edited or altered in any other way. All copyright notices and other references to legal protection must be retained on all copies of this object. The user is responsible for complying with the legal provisions and may be held liable in the event of misuse.
